Many witnesses on the scene communicated to Chief Sicilia regarding how well of a job Sgt. Dorsch did with effectively handling the situation.

After receiving his award, Sgt. Dorsch expressed his gratitude to Chief Sicilia, Captain DeWick, and all the additional NRPD Officers who responded to the call and assisted with the evacuation.
